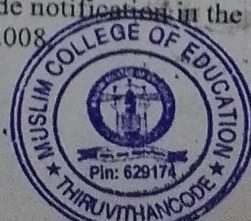

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The application submitted by Muslim College of Education, Kanyakumari District together with the report of the Inspection Commission has been considered by the Syndicate on 01.08.2022 and passed orders to grant continuation of provisional affiliation to Muslim College of Education to offer B.Ed and M.Ed degree programme for three academic years from 2022-2023 to 2024-2025 subject to the condition of rectifying following deficiencies and submission of relavant required documents by the Management of the College of Education within six months.

1. Building License issued by Tahsildar for current period.
2. Pollution Control Certificate from concerned authority for current period
3. Sanitary Certificate issued by competent authority for current period.
4. Last three months' Salary of the faculty through ECS (Electronic Clearing System) for B.Ed/M.Ed degree programme
5. Land Area, If it is wet land, wet land conversion issued by Directorate of Town and Country Planning as per the new section 47(A) of the Tamil Nadu Town and Country planning Act 1971 as notified in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette dated 01.01.2011 shall be furnished.
6. Certificate under Section 37(B) of Tamil Nadu Land Reforms (Land fixation and Ceiling) Act, 1961, vide notification in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette dated 10.06.2010.
7. Documentary evidence for payment of Infrastructure and amenity charges as per Tamil Nadu Gazette Notification regarding Levy of Infrastructure and Amenities Charges Rules 2008, vide notification in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette dated 26.01.2008

I am, by direction, to inform you that the request of Muslim College of Education, Kanyakumari District together with the report of the Inspection Commission, compliance report submitted by the college has been considered and orders have been accorded to grant continuation of provisional affiliation to Muslim College of Education to offer B.Ed and M.Ed degree course for three academic years vide reference cited.

In pursuance of the above orders, continuation of provisional affiliation is granted to Muslim College of Education, Kanyakumari District to offer B.Ed and M.Ed degree programme for the academic years 2019-2020 to 2021-2022.

Further, the Management should remit Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh only) for three academic years 2019-2020 to 2021-2022 to offer B.Ed degree programme another Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh only) for three academic years 2019-2020 to 2021-2022 to offer M.Ed degree programme towards "Affiliation fee" on or before 14.11.2019, failing which the Continuation of Provisional Affiliation now granted will automatically become invalid and the Management should not admit the students in the Muslim College of Education, Kanyakumari from the academic year 2020-2021.

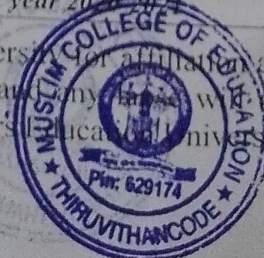
