

#### CIMR VISIT REPORT

The following observations were made by Teacher-trainees of Muslim College of Education, No. 1, New Street, Thiruvithancode ON 26<sup>th</sup> September 2022 during a visit to the Central Institute on Mental Retardation (CIMR) is a voluntary, social service organization, one of the large national level NGO in India working for the welfare and rehabilization of mentally challenged persons.

#### **About CIMR**

CENTRAL INSTITUTE ON MENTAL RETARDATION (CIMR) is a voluntary, social service organization, one of the large national level NGO in India working for the welfare and rehabilization of mentally challenged persons. Rev. Fr. THOMAS FELIX, CMI, a catholic priest who devoted his life for the cause of mentally disabled children in India founded this organization. The governing board members of this NGO are parents of mentally challenged and their friends and well-wishers. The aim of this organization is to work for the total development of the mentally challenged and their friends in India by acquiring and disseminating information on methods of normalizing them; and to promote awarenss of this problem among parents and public.

#### The school follows a special curriculum (The three C's concept)

Knowing the shapes (concept building), making the shaps (carpentary and stitching) selecting the shapes (cycle assembling) and

combining the shaps (Home management class which includes cooking, washing and ironing clothes, bed making, cleaning classrooms, bathrooms, toilet, surroundings, etc.). Academic, drawing, painting, health and hygienc, horticulture, time and money concept, general knowledge, sports and games (both indoor and outdoor), dance, vocal music and instrumental music (table, mridangam, guitar, jazz, drums, organ, bongos and harmonium and band.

First the Teacher-trainees were introduced to a room where students are giving training in the three c's concept.

In the next room training were given the basic training and colours. It is the first class based on shapes based curriculum. The shapes of concrete objects are understood by the five senses. Learning through shapes, we aim at learning letters, numbers, reading and writing.

#### Making the shapes

It is our second class. This class aims at 'Making the shapes' and 'giving shapes and forms'.

#### Selecting the shapes

Then we visited another class. There instruction is given to select the shapes according to nds. Here the students achieve the "decisionmaking" power to select the necessary shapes and to eliminate.



The visit was strange experience to all teacher-trainees. Mental retardation is a condition or incomplete development of mind it cannot be cured. However associated disabilities (sensory, speech problem, behaviour problem etc) can be cured to some extent. To be diagnosted as mentally retarded a person must be significantly subaverage in both intelligence and adaptive behaviour. Mentally retarded are human being like any of us. They can learn a variety of responses and have the same needs, emotions and feelings as normal child. Their education aims at

- (a)Occupational adequency
- (b) Social competence and
- (c)Personal adequency

The early years are very important years to learn basic self-help skills and social adequency. Parents play an important role in the care and education of the mentally retarded children. Several studies reveal that mental retardation is determined by socio-economic condition of parents or environmental deprivation. Organized education and effection guidance can held a retarded child to become self-sufficient and useful member of society.
