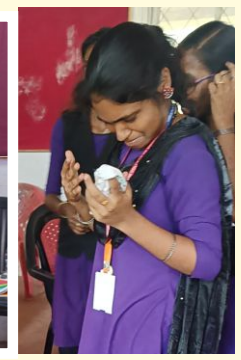

The submission should include the author's name and the nature of their contribution (e.g., main author, co-author, corresponding). A telephone number and email address that correspond to it are mandatory. Submission of a title not exceeding 20 words is required. Footnotes must be incorporated.

Submission Details

No abstract is required. Submit your full paper online on or before 10th February 2024. Your article will be published in International Journal of Research in Education, an International Journal with the ISSN 2456-3412 after scrutiny by the expert committee. Regarding delegates, hotel arrangements will be provided. Conference certificate will be distributed to all registered scholars in the valedictory session of the conference by hand/registered post.
