B.Ed. student headed the traditional practices of cooking Pongal along with other student teachers. This delicacy is made from newly harvested rice boiled with milk and jaggery, coconut and ghee along with spices such as cardamom, raisins and cashews. The overflow of the milk is seen as a symbol of prosperity and abundance and students celebrated that moment by shouting 'Pongalo Pongal'.
