

A cotton bud, a piece of paper, a bowl and lemon juice


Procedure:

# Aluminium

Aluminium with its innumerable merits is not actually obtained in the form in which we see it. Aluminium is separated from bauxite, its ore, after several complicated process. Attempts to separate aluminium from its ore started centuries back. In 1825 Hans Christian oersted of Denmark separated aluminum from its ore using the amalgan of potassium.

Later Fredrich wholer, a German chemist, modified oersted's process of extraction by using metallic potassium instead of the amalgam.

In 1854 Henri sainte-Chaire Deville created a metallic compound using a mixture of aluminium chloride and sodium.









## Jewish:

The Jewish calendar is a lunar calendar adapted to the solar year. It normally has 12 months but in years, which occurs seven times in every cycle of 19 years, there are 13 months. The years are reckoned from the creation (which is placed at 3761 Bc); the months are Nisan, Iyyar, Sivan, Thammuz, Ab, Elul Tishri, Hesvan, Kislev, Tebet, Sebat, and Adar, with an intercalary month (First Adar) being added in leap years.

### Muslim:

The Muslim calendar is based on a year of 12 months, each month beginning roughly at the time of the New Moon. The months are Muharram, Safar, Rabi' I, Rabi'II, Jumada'I, Jumada'II, Rajab, Sha'ban, Ramadan, Shawwal, Dhu I-Qa'dah, and Dhu I-Hijja.

## **Chinese:**


The Chinese calendar is a lunar calendar with a year consisting of 12 months. Intercalary months are added to keep the calendar in step with the solar year of 365 days. Months are referred to by a number within a year, but also by animal names that, from ancient times, have been attached to years and hours of the day.




# Taj Mahal

Taj Mahal, the external love monument, is located in Agra; Shah Jahan commissioned its construction as a mausoleum for his favourite wife, Arjumand Bano Begum, better known as Mumtaz Mahal, in 1631. It was constructed in 22 years (1631-1653) by a workforce of 22000. It is generally considered the finest example of Mughal architecture. The Taj Mahal was not designed by a single person. The project demanded talent from many quarters. Ustad Isa and Isa Muhammad Effendi are credited with a key role in the architectural design of the complex. The main dome was designed by Ismail Khan. Qazim Khan cast the solid gold final that crowned the Turkish master's dome. Chiranjilal was chosen as the chief sculptor and mosaicist. Amanat Khan was the chief calligrapher. Muhammad Hanif was the supervisor of masons. Mir Abdul Karim and Mukkarimat Khan handled finances and the management of daily production.

The Taj rises on a high red sandstone base topped by a huge white marble terrace on which rests the famous dome flanked by four tapering minarets. Within the dome lies the jewel-inlaid cenotaph of the queen. The only asymmetrical object in the Taj the casket of the emperor which was built beside the queen's as an afterthought. It is often described as one of the seven wonders of the modern world.

### Asura:


Marriage by purchase.

Micro teaching advocates the choice and practice of one skill at a time.


The program concluded with a vote of thanks, and sweets were distributed to all the students and staff members.




