No teacher can survive in this dynamic profession, without equipping himself with a variety of skills and qualities that improves his knowledge, ability and quality



New morning, new dreams, new life ...




#### FROM THE ASHES



#### Exhibition - "Pollution as a Global Challenge"

Our environment faces several problems and many of these seem to be worsening with time, bringing us into a time of a true environmental crisis. Therefore enhancing public awareness of these problems is essential to lessen their detrimental effects. Environmental pollution is increasing day by day and imposing severe and irreversible damage to the world. It is of different types: air, water, soil, noise, light, etc. Urbanization and technological development have put the survival of the planet in danger by degrading the quality of the environment's essential elements—air, water and soil—due to the release of hazardous waste from factories like plastics, heavy metals, nitrates, burning of fossil fuels, acid rain, oil spills and industrial toxins. Urbanization and overpopulation have increased city noise and light pollution. Polluting agents are exponentially increasing in modern society, disturbing the ecological balance and posing extinction problems for different animal and bird species. This is because the destruction of plants,













especially trees, by acid rains disturbs the natural environment of animals. The effect of pollution on the health of human being is well known, but it is a dire need to understand the link between environmental pollutants and mental health.

IQAC Muslim College of Education organized an exhibition on the topic "Pollution as a Global Challenge" on 21/07/2023 at Seminar Hall from 10 A.M. to 3.00 P.M. The programme was inaugurated by our respected Secretary, Lion. Dr. H. Mohammed Ali. Our Principal, Dr. V. S. Pramod gave a motivational speech about the most serious problems the humanity and other life forms on our planet is facing today. This event aims to showcase innovative projects and research conducted by teacher trainees regarding the impact of pollution on the environment.

In exhibition student teachers designed various models related to different types of pollution, ecosystem, and climatic change and gave descriptions of the models. The exhibition was organised under the guidance of Miss. M.S. Ashika Mohan, Assistant Professor in English.

Principal, teacher educators and students went around looking at the different models designed by the student teachers. Principal and the teacher educators congratulated all the student teachers who participated in the exhibition


# Anti-Ragging Day: Poster Making Competition conducted on 25/07/2023

"Ragging is any disorderly conduct, whether by words spoken or written, or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which cause or are likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the psyche of a fresher or a junior student."

After the death of a first-year student from Jadavpur University allegedly linked to ragging, University Grant Commission has asked colleges and universities to observe anti-ragging week from August 12 to August 18. The institutions of higher education are directed to implemented anti-ragging measures already spelt out in detail by the UGC and also to organize orientation and induction programmes with a view to encourage students to follow anti-ragging steps on the campus.

Under the direction of UGC and Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University, Muslim College of Education, Thiruvithancode has conducted a poster making competition on "Anti-Ragging" to educate about the evils of ragging and also to spread positive vibes among the students in the college premises. 

Dr. P. Raajan also quoted about Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam's achievements. It was an amazing and useful workshop for all the student teachers.








# Gandhi Jayanti Programme English Essay Writing Competition on 05/10/2023






## Workshop on Vegetable Carving and Flower arrangement held on 22/11/2023

Each day discussions on various topics and hands on training were given to students. After the training the students


